<p><u>Apply to SBCC</u> in Early January for Summer and/or Fall terms.</p> <p>When you are completing your application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you already know your major select the major from the drop down list that matches or is the closest match. ○ Select your Educational Goal as either: Obtain an associate degree and transfer to a 4-year institution or Transfer to a 4-year institution without an associate degree. ○ In the Future Transfer Plans section select the university that you are most interested in attending right now. This is not a final decision. 	
<p>Complete the <u>Steps to Enrollment</u> as soon as possible.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ During your in-person or online advising session you will select your classes for your first semester. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Include the appropriate level math and English courses in your academic plan ▪ If you assess below college level math or English consider joining the <u>Express to Success Program</u> (E.S.P.) ▪ If you assess into college level math and English consider: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joining an <u>IPATH</u> Learning Community or • enrolling in <u>SS 101</u> - Intro to the Social Sciences or <u>BUS 101</u> - Introduction to Business ▪ Consider taking honors courses through the <u>Honors Program</u> ▪ If you are interested in a major in science, technology, engineering or math see if you qualify for the <u>S.T.E.M. Transfer Program</u> (S.T.P.) and take the STEM 101 course ▪ Consider enrolling in a Personal Development (PD) course like <u>PD 100</u> – College Success or <u>PD 110</u> – Career Planning and Decision Making ○ Check out the universities that SBCC has <u>Transfer Admission Guarantees</u> (TAGs) with to see if you can be guaranteed admission to your transfer university ○ Check out SBCC’s <u>Associate Degrees for Transfer</u> (ADT) to see if we have an ADT for your major
